## PROVIDE MEAT AND DAIRY ALTERNATIVES IN YOUR RESTAURANTS

Use your restaurants to educate visitors about how meat and dairy consumption drives deforestation and biodiversity loss

## BUY LOCALLY SOURCED MEAT

Work with your local farmers to understand what their animals are being fed on to reduce embedded soya in your meat products



## CHECK YOUR MEAT AND SOYA SUPPLY CHAIN

Audit your suppliers

## EMPOWER CONSUMER VOICE & CHOICE

Encourage your visitors to support and purchase certified sustainable soya, and ban the use of unsustainable soya



## CERTIFICATION SCHEMES

Where soya is used as animal feed (by your zoo or aquarium, or by your meat suppliers), ensure this is grown to a recommended certification scheme standard

## SUPPORT ACTIVE FOREST PROTECTION

Support field conservation projects in forested areas where protect and restore are key principles



## ENGAGE WITH YOUR LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND INDUSTRY

Encourage improvement of standards within certification schemes and increase support for soya through initiatives
